HOW TO PLEDGE TO NAFSA

Pledging a gift of this kind is a personal decision, one that requires careful thought and planning. You must first, of course, provide for your family and loved ones. After doing so, please remember the role NAFSA has played in your life and the legacy you would like to leave to future generations of committed international educators.

How do you get started?

Simple. Everyone has a unique family and financial situation. Your gift through the New Century Circle can be designed to match your personal circumstances. Even if you already have a will, a codicil can be used to make a minor change in an existing will without the need to execute a new will. Here are several ways to pledge a gift to NAFSA:

- ☉ **Remembering NAFSA in your will.** Bequests allow you to make a larger gift than might have been possible during your lifetime. Bequests are revocable, may be altered as your circumstances change, and allow you to retain full control over your gift. You may choose to have your gift honor or memorialize a loved one, friend, mentor, or respected colleague. A bequest can be a specific gift to NAFSA ("I bequeath the sum of Five Thousand [\$5,000] Dollars"). Or, it can be a percentage of the balance remaining in your estate after taxes and expenses have been paid and other specific bequests have been made. This form of bequest is known as the residue ("I bequeath Ten [10%] Percent of the residue of my estate").
- ☉ **Gifts of Securities.** You may choose to benefit NAFSA through a gift of securities (stocks, bonds, etc.)
- ☉ **Gifts through a life insurance policy.** You can name NAFSA as the direct beneficiary of all or part of your life insurance policy or as a co- or contingent beneficiary. You can also donate your paid life insurance policy to NAFSA.
- ☉ **Gifts of Retirement Plans.** You may designate NAFSA as the final beneficiary of a pension or profit-sharing plan or of a private fund such as an Individual Retirement Account (IRA). IRAs represent a wide range of gift strategies.
- ☉ **Gifts of Bank Accounts or Certificates of Deposit.** NAFSA can be included in your estate plan by naming NAFSA as the beneficiary of a bank account or Certificate of Deposit (CD).
- ☉ **Life Income Gifts.** It may be possible to plan a substantial gift to take effect later, while receiving periodic payments of income from the assets that will eventually come to NAFSA.

MAKING YOUR PLANS

As a member of the New Century Circle, there are various ways to designate your gift. You may direct the gift to:
