Proposed subcommittee Why is it needed? Is the work ongoing?	In accordance with Rule IX, Section C, this request is to renew the charge for the Consular Affairs Liaison (CAL) Subcommittee for two years, until December 2026. Education Abroad professionals benefit from authoritative and up-to-date information about foreign visa requirements/procedures for U.S. students who study abroad, especially about the variations in these requirements by regional consulate offices. The subcommittee serves as a liaison directly with foreign consular officials to seek case-specific assistance for student visa applications. The CAL Subcommittee of the EAKC develops relationships with visa officers at foreign consulates in the United States to clarify visa and immigration procedures for education abroad colleagues. These requirements are always in flux and therefore the work of CAL is ongoing.

In supporting the NAFSA Strategic Plan, this EAKC subcommittee will provide resources to educate EA professionals on visa requirements, advocate for greater clarity in visa requirements and processes, and innovate in the dissemination of information.
